The lessons are differentiated according to the type of school and given by a group of archaeologists from the Federico II University, Naples.

Taking the cue from the finds exhibited in the Museum, lessons will focus on Ancient Roman's traditional life, architectures of domestic spaces, public areas and funeral rites. A specific lesson will be given on Trajan's Column and the Imperial Fora that can be seen from the museum.
